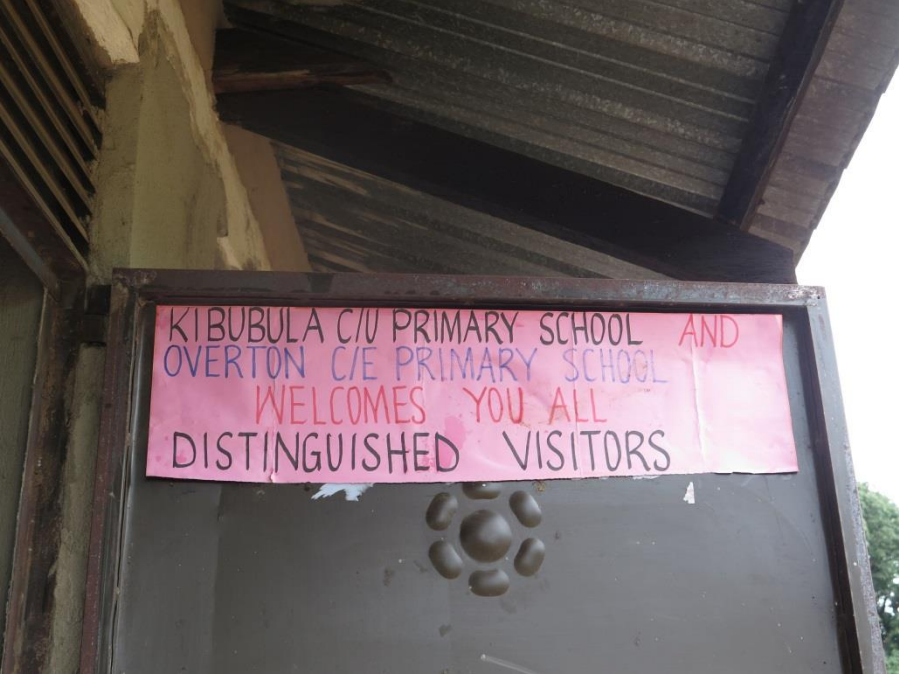

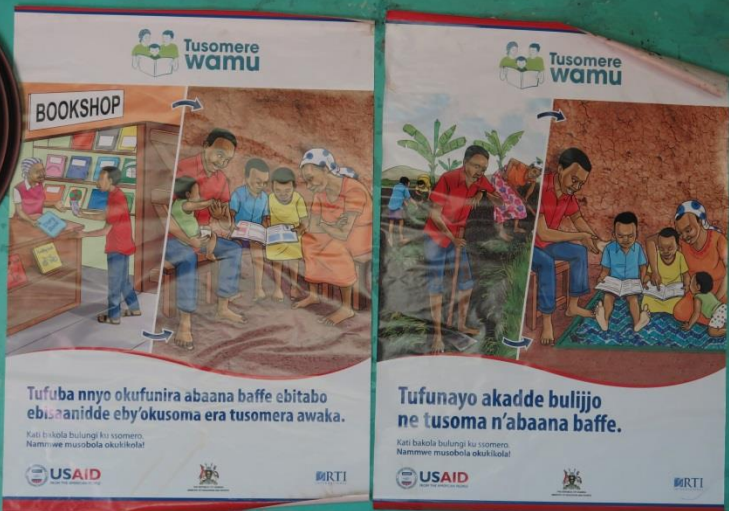


Positives

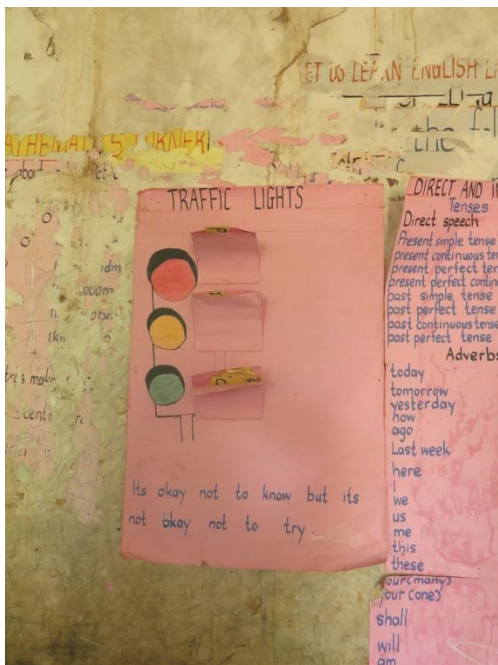
There were lots of positives seen during the visit to Kibubula!

- The original water tank needs some repair
- Termites are in two of the three buildings
- The floors in three classrooms need repair
- All classrooms need to be plastered, have skirting boards and to be painted
- Some more guttering is needed at the rear of the main block and to the front
- 5 new metal doors are needed and plastering to the existing metal doors to secure them
- Small block of 2 classrooms needs a veranda, repair to the stone work and removal of some soil and vegetation
