1) Concepts and skills

- What does the taught curriculum look like?

One of the main focus is experience and interest

Not explicitly taught but interweaved through stories and texts they read, experiences they have

Looking at history within their lifetime. Exploring from baby to present school day

Extended history, not within their lifetime. Looking at dinosaurs, nativity

- What does the environmental curriculum look like?

Small world play. For example, having tuff tray filled with small animals and things to support and explore discussions. This is complimented by simple non-fiction texts or a visitor.

Roleplay

Explore baby photos

Artefacts – dinosaurs and Chinese new year

Playing and exploring. They explore fossils, artefacts. Ask questions, I wonder, I notice, I think
