

## Review of Pupil Premium Strategy 2022-2023

### Attendance 2021-2022

Non PP attendance was 94.36% compared with PP attendance of 90.75% - a gap of -3.61%

### Attendance 2022-2023

Non PP attendance was 95.87% compared with PP attendance of 92.22% - a gap of -3.79%

Attendance was a focus in 2022-2023 and continues to be. Whilst the attendance of all pupils has improved, there is still a gap between non Pupil Premium and Pupil Premium which needs to be narrowed. This will be monitored and parents engaged as needed in 2023-2024.

Whilst attainment in Reading and Maths for PP has improved over the year, the gap with non PP children continues except for Year 2 Reading and Maths. Also, there is work to be done focusing on Writing (whole school challenge)

Children in receipt of PP are tracked and discussed with year groups at half termly Pupil Progress meetings. They are a focus for Phase Leaders monitoring to ensure that work is adapted and meets needs. Where issues are identified these are followed up robustly.
