

## After School & Breakfast Club Agreement

Our breakfast and afterschool clubs aim to provide a fun, caring pre and after school environment. In order for this to happen for all children, everyone needs to play their part.

This agreement explains the expectations of the different people involved.

The clubs will:

- provide a child-centred, fun and safe environment with access to a range of play opportunities both inside and outside the school building (*weather permitting*);
- ensure there is adequately qualified staff to fulfil legal adult/child ratios;
- provide a choice of healthy food and drink;
- support the children to take part in extra curricular activities that take place on the school site e.g. collect them from after school sports activities or escort them to the events laid on by the OSA.
- treat all children equally and with respect;
- record incidents of unacceptable behaviour and report serious or persistent inappropriate behaviour directly to the Head Teacher;
- discuss any incidents of unacceptable behaviour with the parents of the children concerned;
- adhere to the relevant school's policies;

We expect the children to:

- respect each other, staff and visitors, speaking to them politely and following their instructions;
- play in a safe and sensible way;
- take responsibility for their behaviour;
- follow club expectations including eating and drinking seated at a table and tidying up their activities when they have finished playing.

Parents will:

- drop off/pick up their children in accordance with club policies;
- cancel club sessions if no longer needed prior to 24hrs before the club starts or accept the full charge.
- discuss with their child, away from the clubs, any incidents of inappropriate behaviour.
- book sessions in the understanding of this agreement and the pricing policy.
