

Breakfast and After School

FAQs

As promised please find below some more information about the Breakfast and After School Club. We have had a few of questions in overnight so have incorporated replies into this communication.

What are the hours of Breakfast and After School Club and who is running it?

Breakfast club runs from 7.30am until the start of school.

After School Club runs from the end of school up until 4.30pm (half session) or end of school until up to 6pm for a full session.

Sessions will be run by LSA's at the school.

How much will Breakfast and after school Club cost?

Breakfast Club costing £6.00 per session.

After School Club costing £6.00 for half a session and £12.50 for a full session.

On Friday's we only run a half session for ASC which will take place after the Friday afternoon club is needed.

How do I book a place?

You will need to book the sessions you require via School Money

Where do I drop off and collect from?

When dropping off your child, you will need to drop off at the community door near front entrance. Collection will be the same place at the end of each session, if you choose to collect earlier then you will need to collect from the back playground.

What will be taking place at the club?

The club will be a mixture of outdoor play, sports and games as well as indoor creative opportunities, construction and games. This will be developed over time when we know how many children we have and what their preferences are.

Why are you not taking Childcare Vouchers?

We have made the decision not to accept any new childcare vouchers on the basis that refunds are very problematic due to the tax implications. As much as we hope that the club runs all year it is not out of the question that should a localised outbreak occur we would have to review the club. Payments can be easily be refunded but childcare vouchers can't.

Of course we will honour any childcare vouchers credits that exist on childcare accounts and will transfer any balances that exist onto younger siblings from our year 6 children.

Can I book a half session for after an activity based session (for example a Sports Xtra or school run club) has finished?

No. The half session option is for the first half session only – End of school to 4.30pm.

Should you wish to have your child attend ASC for the second half you will need to book a full session and then inform us of the other club booking. This is due to ensuring staffing requirements are met and not prevent too many empty spaces when demand appears high.

Is there a Club Agreement?

There will be an agreement covering the 'rules' of the club, cancellation policy and late pick up charges etc. This is currently under development.
